Mark introduced Dr Zaid to inform us about the Vanguard and Multispecialty Community Provider (MCP) Project

Principles

10 Practices agree to work together with the following principles.

The list-based partnership model will underpin the MCP.

Practices will define the clinical service models themselves through mutual agreement.

Continuity of care will be maintained for patients.

All parties will be open and honest in their dealings with one another.

All staff will be involved and listened to.

Patients and the public will be involved and listened to.

New or different job roles may be developed but the aim is for no job losses.

Objectives

Practices will benefit from:

- a. New ways of working with greater influence on other providers.
- b. Identifying all possible opportunities for the sustainability of practice income.
- c. Reduced pressure within individual practices.

Patients will benefit from:

- a. Joined up care between multiple providers.
- b. Improved GP access.
- c. Better management of long-term conditions by using appropriate specialists.

There will be 2 representatives out of the 10 practices.
